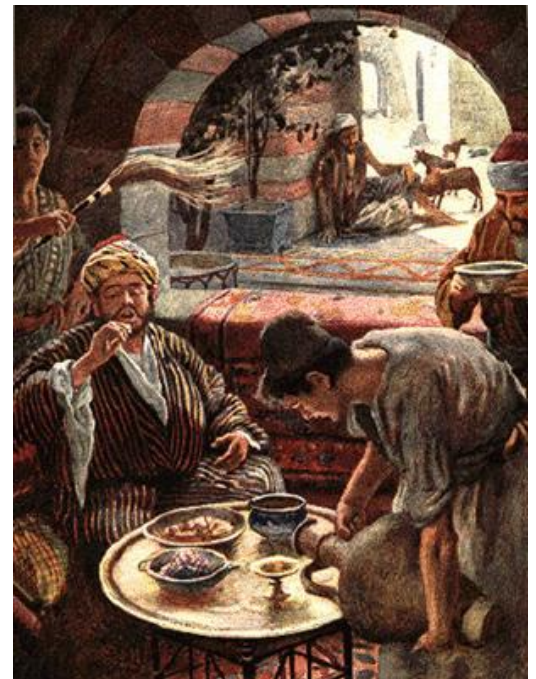

Points about Prayer

1. It can help to kneel, or sit respectfully when you pray. Your body, mind and soul are one. The way you position your body is important



2. Start by remembering God is present everywhere. Speak to him in your own words. Speak to him of your faith, your hope and your love. Give him thanks for the good things in your life. Ask for his help in your difficulties and sorrows. Seek his guidance.

3. God likes to converse with you the way you like to converse with others: He doesn't want to hear you rattle on and hardly notice him.

4. If you get stuck and find it hard to say something, you can slowly repeat the words of a simple prayer such as: "My God give me the grace to love you above all things and my neighbour as myself". Read the Gospel of Luke 11: 1- 4

5. Read a brief passage from the Gospels and picture it happening. You can even imagine Jesus sitting with you.
